DIVERSE:

STTG: A nice surprise today: another yellow-browed warbler! We were not expecting to get any more of this lovely species, it's quite late for them now... this is the latest ringing record in Ottenby. It was successfully MOTUS tagged as part of our ongoing project. A black redstart was also a nice highlight.

AND: 2 teal and 6 mallards ringed, and lots of ducks controlled, as is per usual these days.

Div: A pallas's leaf warbler was seen in the garden today! Also quite late for this species... JMS made an attempt to trap twites in Norrvik with a single-shelf mist net but didn't succeed. ALD left for a few days. A pine grosbeak was heard in the southern forest... first one in Ottenby area this year! We tried to find it but without success.. we really hope more come in the remainder of the season. The geese have started feeding closer to the garden now, and one barnacle even landed inside momentarily! We really enjoyed the flock of brent geese that was in the garden last autumn (and also a white-fronted goose!) so we hope this year the situation repeats itself.
